This expansion will ultimately allow us to perform an additional 6,000 surgeries annually and provides many upgrades and improvements that we are eager to share with you!


Thanks to you and all of our amazing donors, we have currently raised \$287,000 toward our \$450,000 Phase I goal!

Johnson County Humane Society (JCHS) is dedicated to spaying and neutering free roaming cats in our communities and facilitates the Florence Unash Fund

to assist with the cost of surgery for animals within Johnson County.

Since IHA opened they have spayed and neutered over 1000 animals with Unash funding assistance.

We know that spaying and neutering not only reduces community cat populations, it also improves their health. Felix is a free roaming cat who has been cared for

at four colonies in North Liberty. He was estimated to be at least 10 years old when he was trapped.

Since he's been neutered and vaccinated, he's put on weight and he's got more pep in his step!

JCHS will continue to work tirelessly to spay and neuter as many cats as we possibly can with the help of IHA.
